



## NEWFANE TOWN CONSTABLE



A Constable is a public official who is elected or appointed rather than hired. Constables are considered peace officers (NYS Criminal Procedure Section 2.10) and have law enforcement powers within their jurisdiction while on duty (Section 2.10). All Constables must either go through the New York State approved Peace Officer Training or have completed a Police Officer Academy as outlined by the New York State Division of Criminal Justice. Constables within the Town of Newfane serve at the direction of the Town Supervisor, Town Board or the Town Court in the capacity of:

- 1) Court Officer
- 2) Town Board meeting security
- 3) Community event security
- 4) Assist the Town Building Inspector, Town patrol activities
