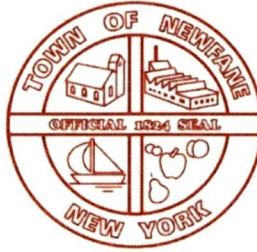

RESOLUTION #43-2026 OF THE TOWN BOARD, TOWN OF NEWFANE, NY

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN SUPERVISOR TO EXECUTE A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF NIAGARA FOR THE USE OF KRULL PARK FOR THE 2026 OLCOTT BEACH BAND ORGAN RALLY

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara is the owner of a park and recreation area known as Krull Park, located in the Town of Newfane; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Newfane wishes to use Krull Park and its facilities on July 24 through July 26, 2026, for the purpose of hosting the Olcott Beach Band Organ Rally, a recreational and cultural event open to the residents of the Town of Newfane and the County of Niagara; and

WHEREAS, the County of Niagara is agreeable to granting the Town a license for such use, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in a proposed License Agreement, including provisions governing security, insurance, indemnification, and compliance with applicable County and State Health Department requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed the proposed License Agreement and finds that hosting the Olcott Beach Band Organ Rally at Krull Park serves a legitimate municipal recreational and cultural purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board wishes to authorize the Town Supervisor to execute the License Agreement, in a form approved by the Attorney for the Town, and to take such further steps as are necessary or appropriate to effectuate its terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Newfane hereby approves the License Agreement between the County of Niagara and the Town of

Newfane for the use of Krull Park on July 24 through July 26, 2026, for the purpose of hosting the Olcott Beach Band Organ Rally; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the License Agreement, in a form approved by the Attorney for the Town, on behalf of the Town of Newfane; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town Supervisor is further authorized to take such actions and to execute such additional documents as may be necessary or appropriate to effectuate the terms of the License Agreement, including, without limitation, the procurement and submission of a certificate of insurance satisfying the requirements of the License Agreement.

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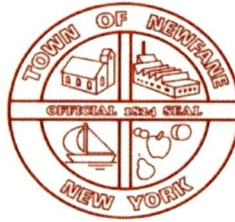
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RESO #43-2026 Attachment 1

The Town of Newfane Constables will be present during the hours of the event. The Niagara County Sheriff's Office has assigned the vehicle as #230, and Officers Jeffrey Newman is #231, Joseph Flagler is # 232 and Ken Nerber is # 233.

These Officers are trained in First Aid, along with CPR and AED. Their radio frequency is tied to the NCSO Dispatch. They will notify Dispatch of their presence on the days of the event.

Olcott Fire Co. will also be on stand-by.
