



RESOLUTION #23-2025

RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF NEWFANE DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES FOR MARINA DOCK REPAIR AND RELOCATION OF MECHANICAL AND ELECTRICAL COMPONENTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to New York State Town Law and General Municipal Law, the Town of Newfane is required to follow competitive bidding and procurement procedures for the acquisition of goods and services, except in cases of emergency; and

WHEREAS, due to unforeseen conditions, the Town of Newfane docks have suffered damage requiring immediate repair to protect public safety, safeguard municipal property, and prevent further deterioration; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has further determined that in order to complete the dock repair and replacement, it is necessary to relocate associated mechanical and electrical components; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence in addressing these conditions, and the delay occasioned by compliance with normal procurement procedures would pose a threat to public property, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, under New York State General Municipal Law §103(4), in the case of a public emergency arising out of an accident or other unforeseen occurrence, or condition whereby circumstances affecting public buildings, public property, or the life, health, safety, or property of the inhabitants require immediate action which cannot await competitive bidding, a municipality may award contracts without competitive bidding to address such emergency;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Newfane hereby declares that an emergency exists with respect to the Town dock requiring immediate repair; and
